Draft Environmental Impact Statement

As part of the legally mandated National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process, the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) and Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) invite the public to attend virtual public hearings on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (DEIS), Section 4(f) Evaluation, and Draft Section 106 Programmatic Agreement for the Baltimore-Washington Superconducting Magnetic Levitation (SCMAGLEV) Project. The Project is a magnetic levitation railway system that would operate between Washington, DC and Baltimore, Maryland, with a station at BWI Thurgood Marshall Airport.

Publication of the DEIS in January 2021 was a milestone in the NEPA and National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) compliance processes. The DEIS and Section 4(f) Evaluation documents are available for viewing and download at bwmaglev.info. Virtual Public Hearings

Due to the current COVID-19 protocols, the Public Hearings will be held virtually. The Virtual Public Hearings provide an opportunity for attendees to provide live or private individual testimony on the DEIS and the SCMAGLEV Project. All testimony will be recorded by an official Court Reporter. There will be no formal presentation during the testimony sessions, and no responses to questions will be given. All comments will be included as part of the official record.

To provide live individual testimony, speakers are required to pre-register for one of the hearing dates and times at bwmaglev.info. Please sign up only once to provide verbal testimony. Private testimony can be provided during the hearings by calling 855-450-1219 and selecting the option to record a voicemail. Members of the public will have three minutes per person to give testimony (public or private). Each of the six hearing sessions will follow the same format and will be broadcast on the project website and via telephone at 855-450-1219. Additional instructions on how to provide live testimony will be emailed to the registrants as the hearing dates approach.
